SPECIAL CALLED COUNCIL MEETING-CANVASSING THE ELECTION
May 12, 2026 - 6:00 P.M.

The City Council of the City of Forest Hill met on the above date at 6:00 p.m. with Mayor Boardingham presiding. The following Council members and Officials were present: Carlie Jones, Timey Boardingham, Anthony Cook, Janet Carpenter, Keith R. Smith, Sonja Coleman, Interim City Manager Demond Spraberry, and City Secretary Amy Anderson.

1. Call to Order

With a quorum present, Mayor Boardingham called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m.

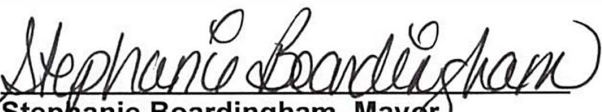
