**MINUTES
 PARKS, RECREATION, AND CLEAN CITY COMMISSION
 May 11, 2026**

The Parks, Recreation, and Clean City Commission met on the above date at 5:00 p.m. with Chairwoman Pearl Jones presiding. The following Commissioners and Officials were present: Darryl Givens, Rayford Johnson, Quincy Wallace, Brian King, Public Works Director Roberto Duenes, and City Secretary Amy Anderson.

Commissioner Albert Harris was absent from the meeting.

Commissioner Brian King arrived at 5:10 p.m.

Chairwoman Jones informed the Commission that Commissioner Larry Taylor resigned.

1. Call to Order

With a quorum present, Chairwoman Jones called the meeting to order at 5:05 p.m.
